2008 FOOD VENDOR INFORMATION

- All submissions will be reviewed individually for menu variety (including vegetarian, organic and/or international menu items), healthy choices, price range and how well the booth fits into the festival setting. Recognition will be provided for vendors who use meats and vegetables that are grown and raised locally and for booth appearance.
- All food vendors, successful and unsuccessful, will be notified by May 1st at the latest. (We realize that you may have other commitments.)
- The Georgian Bay Folk Society will provide booth space, electricity, water and a grey water disposal area. Vendors are required to provide their own booth materials and equipment. **In addition to the application form, you must submit a detailed sketch setting out the dimensions and design of the booth; photographs are also accepted.**
- Power is limited so please indicate on your application what your power requirements are by indicating what equipment you propose to use.
- We encourage our food vendors to use environmentally friendly practices, to recycle where possible and to limit non-recyclable packaging materials and refuse. Garbage pick up will be ongoing at no charge.
- Food Vendors agree to pay the Georgian Bay Folk Society 15% of all gross sales. The Georgian Bay Folk Society agrees to redeem 85% of the face value of all food tickets tendered, by cheque, post Summerfolk weekend and no later than September 11th, 2008.
- If accepted, the food vendor will be forwarded a contract for signing, which must be returned no later than the **15th of June 2008**. A deposit in the sum of \$150.00 is required with the return of the signed contract. This deposit shall be returned on or before the 11th of September 2008, provided that the food vendor has abided by all the terms and conditions set out in the contract. Please note that if the food vendor does not abide by the terms and conditions of the contract, the deposit is deemed to have been forfeited to the Georgian Bay Folk Society.
- Proof of Liability Insurance must be provided no later than August 1st, 2008.
- On site set-up is to be completed by 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 14th to permit installation of electrical services. Dismantling of the booth must be completed no later than 1:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 19th, 2008.
- Food booths will operate on Friday, August 15th, 2008 from 4:30 p.m. to 11:00 p.m., on Saturday, August 16th, 2008 from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. and on Sunday, August 17th, 2008 from 11:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Food booths **may** be permitted to close at 9:00 p.m. on Sunday, August 17th if previously arranged with the Folk Society.
- Food vendors will be provided with one parking space in the North parking lot.

- The Georgian Bay Folk Society will be solely responsible for the sale of food tickets for the food concession booth. Food tickets shall be in .25, \$1.00 and \$5.00 denominations. All food items offered for sale by the food vendor shall be priced in denominations consistent with the denominations used by the Georgian Bay Folk Society on their food tickets. Food tickets may be redeemed by the food vendor on site at specific times or by cheque, post Summerfolk, no later than September 11th, 2008. **No cash sales will be allowed.**

Deadline for submission is April 15, 2008.
